

Working Title Rules

The Cinematic Re-Name Game

Designed by Danielle Reynolds & Rob Reynolds

Contents:

- 100 double-sided cards
- 6 dry erase boards
- 6 dry erase markers
- 1 D6 die
- Rulebook

Objective:

A creative party game about renaming classic movie loglines into new and creative titles!

Set-Up:

1. Hand each player a dry erase marker and board.
2. Shuffle all the logline cards into a single deck.
3. Hand the die to the player who most recently watched a movie. They are the starting player.

How to Play:

1. Roll a 6-sided die to determine the genre of film (Romance, Drama, Comedy, Horror, Action-Adventure, or You Choose) for the other players.
2. Have the active player draw a logline card and read it out loud.
3. All other players will write a new title for the movie logline based on the genre rolled.
 - a. Once you are finished writing, put down the clapper on the whiteboard.
4. The judge will choose their favorite and award that player with the card as a point.
5. Pass the die clockwise to the new active player and repeat until a player has collected 5 points worth of cards.

Winning:

The first player to win 5 cards is the winner!
